<b>1</b>	Co-sponsored Job Fairs	On April 14, 2009 and Oct. 13 2009, the station employment unit (“SEU”) co-sponsored the Amarillo Job Fair with four other organizations including the Texas Workforce Commission and Bell Helicopter. As the only broadcast entity hosting the fair, the SEU had the responsibility of advertising the fair and also marketing the event to area businesses. Over 100 employers participated in the fair. The director of sales and the human resources director helped organize the event.
<b>2</b>	Sponsored event in the community designed to inform and educate members of the public about employment in broadcasting	In October the SEU participated in a annual local University “Recruitment Party” for the general public. During this event, members of the public are invited to the WT Campus to participate in a mass recruitment opportunity. Participants watch videos about the company, participate in a round table discussion, complete applications and set up interviews. Participants are solicited through on-air recruitment and through the master recruitment source list. The director of sales, general manager, and human resources director took part in this event.
<b>3</b>	Internship Program	In the Spring of 2009, the SEU had one intern from West Texas A&M University. This intern rotated through the departments at the stations, spending ten weeks in sales and programming/promotions.
